

# MONITORING SYSTEMATIC PARTICIPATION OF ADOLESCENTS AND YOUTH IN PROGRAMMES

## Overview

---

A critical element is to assess the effectiveness of the engagement programmes implemented. Sessions 10 and 11 provide an overview of what we should measure and provide participants with simple tools to monitor adolescent and youth engagement.

Session 10 focusses specifically on monitoring systematic participation of adolescent and youth programmes.

## Instructions

---

- 1- **Plenary discussion (10 min):** Reflection on the key elements of a project cycle and the type of measurement feasible followed by a quick review of the tool.
  
- 2- **Group discussion (35 min):**
  - a. **Self-Assessment in Agency groups (15 min)**

Participants are grouped at the agency level, and each agency reviews level of systematic engagement of their organization/programmes.

What were some of the key challenges faced?

Were there any good practices that could be shared with others?
  - b. **Group sharing (15 min)**
    - i. Challenges in monitoring and how to overcome them (Examples within the group)
    - ii. Identify promising and good practices
  
- 3- **Plenary Feedback (30 min):** discussion, recommendations and lessons learned
  - a. Highlight the challenges in M&E for systematic engagement
  - b. Share the promising and good practices of systematic engagement and explain how they can overcome the challenges
