



**ACHIEVEMENTS**

In the first quarter of 2015, the Education Sector has reached a total number of 469,184 affected children and adolescents including 213,550 children in hard to reach areas and 84,704 Palestine refugees, through the provision of access and the enhancement of the quality of teaching and learning as well as through capacity building for education actors to deliver an effective education response and the rehabilitation of schools damaged by the conflict.

The education response is aimed at enhancing the resilience of most vulnerable communities through the provision of quality education in line with the education strategic framework of the No Lost Generation Initiative (NLG), INEE Minimum Standards and the 2015 SRP.

Cross-cutting and sector integration and inter-agency cooperation have been established to boost complementarity with other sectors such as Child Protection, WASH, Early Recovery (ER) and Nutrition and to enhance the quality and effectiveness of education responses.

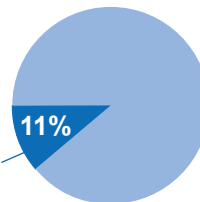
